



SAFETY POSTER DESIGN COMPETITION COMPETITION RULES

1. Aim: To encourage students to give thought to the raising of awareness of hand protection and safety in the workplace.
2. The competition calls for designs for posters to promote the use of gloves in industry to reduce hand injuries at work. The posters should be eye-catching and carry simple messages or slogans for use in the workplace and targeted at those who work there. See poster design brief attached.
3. **PRIZES AND AWARD CEREMONY**
Winner: £300 + a framed Certificate + lunch at the Prizegiving ceremony.
Runner-up: £100 + a framed Certificate + lunch at the Prizegiving ceremony.

The college judged to have contributed the best series of designs to the competition will be given a framed certificate and the course tutor will be given lunch at the Prizegiving ceremony.

The prize-giving will take place in July 2010 at a formal lunch in a prestigious City of London venue. The first prize-winner and the Runner-up, together with the tutor receiving the certificate for the best series of designs, will be our guests. Award winning students may also bring, at their own expense, one personal guest to the event (the cost has normally been about £70).

6. The competition is open to all Further Education Institutions in the UK. All entries, to be selected by the Head of Department, must have the official entry form affixed to the reverse of the design.
7. Entries can only be accepted from an individual student – joint entries will not be judged.
8. Each design must be submitted on A3 size paper. The decision of the panel of judges, who will be drawn from the safety glove industry, will be final.
9. Entries (with the exception of the prize winners) may be returned after judging has taken place to those colleges who submit the return postage with the entries. The winning entries and any copyright therein will remain the property of the British Glove Association. All students are therefore advised to copy their designs before submission.
